

Cookie Policy

Our Cookies Policy forms part of, and is subject to our Terms and conditions.

- 1.1 As with other platforms, we use cookies and similar technologies to help us understand how people use our Platform so that we can continue to improve our service.
- 1.2 With this Cookies Policy, we want to provide you with clear and explicit information about the cookies and technologies we use on our Platform and your choices regarding aforementioned.
 - 1.3 If you Use our Platform without blocking or disabling cookies or opting out of other technologies, you are indicating your consent to our use of these cookies and other technologies and to our use (in accordance with this Cookies Policy and our Privacy Policy) of any data and personal data (i.e. data that identifies you, or from which you are identifiable) ("Data") that is yours that we collect using these cookies and technologies. If you do not consent to the use of these cookies and technologies, you will need to block or disable them using your browser settings.
 - 1.4 If you choose not to accept Cookies from us or our third parties, or if you accept Cookies but subsequently disable some or all of the Cookies through your browser settings, you won't have access to many features that make your experience with us more efficient and some of our Platform may not function properly.



WHAT ARE COOKIES?

- 2.1 A cookie is a text file placed on your computer or device when you visit a website by that website's server ("Cookie"). Only that server is able to retrieve or read the contents of that Cookie. Each Cookie is unique to your web browser and contains some anonymous information such as a unique identifier, the site name and some other digits and numbers.
- 2.2 Cookies can be "persistent" or "session" cookies. Cookies can 'remember' you either for the duration of your visit i.e. they are deleted as soon as you close your browser ("Session Cookie") or for a number of visits i.e. they remain on your computer when you have gone off-line ("Persistent Cookie").
- 2.3 Session and Persistent Cookies can be either first or third party Cookies. A first party Cookie will be placed on your computer or device by us and a third party Cookie will be placed on your computer or device by a different website (for example, we use Google Analytics to gather anonymised information which we analyse to monitor traffic to our Site).

3. WHY WE USE COOKIES

- 3.1 We use Cookies to improve your experience of our Site.
- 3.2 Cookies do many things such as enabling you to navigate between pages efficiently, storing your preferences and making the interaction



between you and our Site faster and easier. For example, Cookies enable you to remain logged into our Site – without Cookies, you would have to log into our Site each time you visited it.

3.3 Some websites also use Cookies to enable them to target their advertising or marketing messages based on your location and / or browsing habits.

4. TYPES OF COOKIES WE USE

4.1 We use the following types of Cookies: (a) Security: These Cookies allow us to promote security on our Site, (b) Analytics: We track Site traffic patterns so we can identify popular Site content and potential Site problems, (c) Site features: We measure how visitors use our Site so we can optimise the web pages and use of our Site, and (d) Advertising: We use non-identifiable information about you to show you advertising on our Site.

5. THIRD PARTY COOKIES

- 5.1 We may include advertising content (graphics, animations, video, etc.) in our broadcast advertising, which may contain Cookies placed by third parties. The placement and the use of Cookies by any such third parties will be subject to the privacy and/or cookies policies of those third parties.
 - 5.2 These Cookies will help the third parties (while the Cookies are valid) to:
- 5.2.1 1. count the number of display advertising content delivered via our advertising; identify advertisements displayed; count the number



of users who clicked on each ad, allowing them to calculate the amounts due and thereby establish statistics; and/or

5.2.2 2. Recognise your device at any subsequent browsing of any other site or service on which these advertisers or third parties also place these Cookies and, if necessary, adapt these third party sites and services or advertisements they broadcast to your device.

5.3 Google Analytics

5.3.1 Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google Inc., uses Cookies to gather information about how visitors use our Site. Google Analytics uses its own Cookies, to analyse the use of our Site on our behalf. The information generated by the Cookies about your use of our Site is transmitted to Google. This information is then used for the purpose of compiling statistical reports to enable us to measure and analyse the number of visits to our Site and its pages, the average time spent on our Site and the pages viewed.

7.1 Introduction: If you have a different browser type or version, please refer to your browser's "Help" menu.

7.2 Internet Explorer 7, 8, and 9: Click on the Tools menu, and then select Internet Options. Click on the Privacy tab. Move the slider to choose your preferred settings. For more specialised cookie settings, click on Sites or Advanced.



- 7.3 Google Chrome: Click on the Chrome menu, and then select Settings. Click Show advanced settings. Click on Content settings to choose your preferred settings.
- 7.4 Mozilla Firefox 14, 15 and 16: Click on the Firefox button (or Tools menu), and then select Options. For Mac OS X users, click on the Firefox menu, and then select Preferences. Click on the Privacy panel to choose your preferred settings. For more specialised cookie settings, set 'Firefox will:' to 'Use custom settings for history.'
- 7.5 Safari 5.1 and Later (Mac OS X): Click on the Safari menu, and then select Preferences. Click on the Privacy tab to display cookie settings. Choose your preferred settings. For more specialised cookie settings, click on Details.
